From a staff of two, 22 years ago at its first location in Torrance, the company now employs over 80. Classic currently operates six South Bay locations: Torrance, Lawndale, Redondo Beach, Rancho Palos Verdes, Gardena and Hawthorne. Classic processes over 3 million pieces of clothing annually, which includes dry cleaning and laundry services. Despite this heavy volume, Classic boasts one of the lowest lost and damaged ratios in the country, less than one-half of one percent. The national average is 3 percent. Classic credits their outstanding track record to a state of the art computer system and dedicated employees.
