Temporary Street Closures in Downtown

Railroad Crossing Repairs

On Tuesday, September 27th through Friday, September 30, 2005 the east and westbound lanes of Torrance Blvd., near Sartori Ave. and west of the Torrance Bridge (Llewellyn Ave.), will be closed intermittently during the repair of the two rail line crossings. The City of Torrance and Union Pacific Railroad Company have joined forces to repair the crossings as shown on the adjacent map as crossing #2 and #3. The asphalt and wooden ties will be replaced by concrete.

Traffic will be detoured and rerouted around the construction area; however, Downtown access will be made available. Detour signs will be installed throughout the area, to assist drivers around the street closures.

The first crossing repair (Cabrillo Ave. at Torrance Blvd.), shown on the adjacent map as #1, was completed earlier this month.
