2. **Refer to Appendix IV “City of Torrance and Caltrans Standard Plans for Pavement Markings” included in the project specifications and specifically to “City Of Torrance Standard Parking Striping”.**

- The “City of Torrance Standard Parking Striping” (double striped spaces) shall be installed only at City Parking Facilities #3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, as listed in the table in Appendix III.
- Parking striping for City Parking Facilities #1 and #2 shall be installed per the “City of Torrance Standard Parking Striping For City Yard Parking Facilities” now hereby added to the specifications and is hereby included with this Addendum.

3. **Refer to the Special Provisions Section 203-5, Slurry Seal, on page E-17.**

Subsection 203-5.1 General is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

“203-5.1 General. Replace the first sentence with the following:

Slurry seal shall be quick-set emulsion-aggregate slurry (EAS), with the addition of 2.5% latex, and is herein referred to as “Slurry.”

Type I Slurry shall be used on City Parking Facility #3, City Hall – Employee Parking Area (North).

Type II Slurry shall be used on all residential streets and on City Parking Facilities #1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, as listed in the tables in Appendix III.”

4. **Refer to Specifications Section C and the Bidder’s Submittal Bid Schedule B on page C-2 and the Bidder’s Submittal Bid Schedule B on the blue-colored paper included with the Contract Documents.**

Bid Schedule B in the above-referenced documents is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with **BID SCHEDULE B REVISED– CITY PARKING FACILITIES (8 LOCATIONS)**, now hereby added to the specifications, contract documents and is hereby included with this Addendum. A bidder shall use **BID SCHEDULE B REVISED– CITY PARKING FACILITIES (8 LOCATIONS)** included with this Addendum when preparing and submitting its bid.




