MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING OF THE TORRANCE CITY COUNCIL

OPENING CEREMONIES:

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The Torrance City Council convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting on Wednesday, April 28, 1976, at 3:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Torrance City Hall.

2. ROLL CALL:

Present: Councilmembers Armstrong, Brewster, Geissert, Rossberg and Mayor Miller. Absent: Councilmembers Surber, Wilson.

Also present: City Manager Ferraro, City Attorney Remelmeyer, and City Clerk Coil.

3. FIELD TRIP BY BUS TO THE "HILLSIDE MORATORIUM" AREA.

Building and Safety Director McKinnon outlined the purpose of the field trip, the concerns to be investigated, sites of specific note, etc. Mr. McKinnon then introduced Mr. Roy Hoffman, Chief Geologist, Converse Davis Dixon Associates, who provided desired clarification on the field trip.

The bus departed at 3:40 P.M. with all interested parties -- the route encompassed Via Valmonte, Mesa, Vista Largo, Vista Montana, and Paseo de las Tortugas.
