MINUTES OF AN EMERGENCY MEETING  
OF THE TORRANCE CITY COUNCIL

OPENING CEREMONIES

1. CALL TO ORDER

The Torrance City Council convened in an emergency meeting on Thursday, April 30, 1992, at 4:31 PM, in the Council Chambers of Torrance City Hall.

ROLL CALL

Present: Councilmembers Applegate, Hardison, Lee, Nakano, O'Donnell, Wirth and Mayor Geissert.

Absent: None.

Also present: City Manager Jackson, City Attorney Nelson, City Clerk Bramhall, and staff representatives.

3. MOTION TO WAIVE FURTHER READING

MOTION: Councilman Applegate moved that after the City Clerk has assigned a number and read title to any resolution or ordinance on the agenda for this meeting, the further reading thereof be waived, reserving and guaranteeing to each Councilmember the right to demand the reading of any such resolution or ordinance in regular order. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman Hardison and roll call vote was unanimously favorable.
