The Political Reform Act requires all candidates for public office in the City of Torrance to file documents with the filing official (City Clerk) prior to raising or spending any money (including personal funds) towards their candidacy. Candidates are further required to form committees (Statement of Organization) within ten days of spending or receiving \$1,000. Complete information and forms are available in the City Clerk's office.

Campaign Finance documents are public records on file in the office of the City Clerk and are available for review during regular business hours.
