Torrance Announces This Year's Essay Question for Students & Government Day Geared Toward Eighth Graders

Torrance, Calif., February 1, 2012 – The City of Torrance announces new topic for its 2012 Students & Government Day, a program to encourage youth participation in community affairs. Selected students will participate in Students & Government Day, which will be held on Tuesday, May 1, 2012.

The City of Torrance encourages all eighth graders to apply for participation by submitting a 100-150 word essay on the prompt: ***"The City of Torrance is celebrating its Centennial (100th Birthday) in 2012. You are a student in 2012 and are traveling back in time to 1912. Selected students will engage in various activities including shadowing the mayor, council members and executive staff in their jobs, then act in those roles they shadowed.
