Second Phase is Complete!

On Wednesday, December 3, reconstruction of Artesia Blvd between Prairie Ave and Yukon Ave was substantially completed. Motorists now drive on a smooth pavement surface with new lane striping. There are now two westbound left-turn lanes at the intersection with Prairie Ave. Traffic circulation has greatly improved. The roadway is open to traffic and on-street parking is now permitted in this section of Artesia Blvd.

Prairie Ave Intersection to be Reconstructed in early 2004

The reconstruction of Artesia Blvd at its intersection with Prairie Ave has been rescheduled to March 2004. It is expected that the intersection will carry a significant amount of traffic during the 2003 Holiday Season. Any construction activity would cause long travel delays. Work is scheduled to begin after the section between Yukon Ave and Crenshaw Blvd is complete.

Construction Started Between Yukon Ave and Crenshaw Blvd

On Thursday, December 4, construction began on Artesia Blvd between Yukon Ave and Crenshaw Blvd. During the next four weeks, work activities will occur within the travel lanes adjacent to the median and also inside the median area. The left-turn lanes from Artesia Blvd onto Yukon Ave, Glenburn Ave, Elgar Ave and Delia Ave are closed and left-turns are prohibited during construction. Once completed, construction will begin on the outside travel lanes and parking lanes.

DECEMBER TRAFFIC INFO

Traffic on Artesia Blvd is reduced to one lane in each direction between Yukon Ave and Crenshaw Blvd. **“NO-PARKING ANYTIME”** signs are posted to prohibit parking on a 24-hour basis for approximately 9 weeks. Warning - Vehicles parked illegally will be towed away.



During construction, the westbound left-turn lane on Artesia Blvd that turns onto southbound Yukon Ave is closed. Please use an alternate route.

Towards the end of December, the eastbound left-turn lane on Artesia Blvd that turns onto northbound Crenshaw Blvd will be closed for approximately 2 weeks. Please plan to use an alternate route.
