Third Phase is Complete!

On February 6, reconstruction of Artesia Blvd between Yukon Ave and Crenshaw Blvd (Phase 3) was completed. This includes the intersection with Yukon Ave. Motorists now drive on a smooth pavement surface with new lane striping. The roadway is open to traffic and on-street parking is now permitted in this section of Artesia Blvd. There are a total of five phases of which three are now complete.

TRAFFIC INFORMATION

Artesia Blvd in the vicinity of Prairie Ave

Eastbound and westbound traffic will be reduced to one (1) lane in each direction. Left and right turns will be prohibited onto Prairie Ave, when required.

Prairie Ave in the vicinity of Artesia Blvd

Northbound and southbound traffic will each be reduced to one (1) lane approaching Artesia Blvd. Vehicles will be prohibited from crossing Artesia Blvd and limited to making either a left or right turn, when required by the construction.

Beginning February 23, traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction on a 24-hr basis between Crenshaw Blvd and Van Ness Ave.



Reconstruction begins at the Prairie Ave Intersection

Reconstruction of the intersection of Artesia Blvd and Prairie Ave began on February 9 and will be ongoing for approximately four weeks.

Construction in the intersection will be completed in individual stages and it will be necessary to close various travel lanes during the four-week period. Depending on the individual stage it also will be required to prohibit left and right turns, as needed.

Please plan to use an alternate route to avoid significant travel delays.
