Construction begins between Crenshaw Blvd and Van Ness Ave!

On February 23, reconstruction began on Artesia Blvd between Crenshaw Blvd and Van Ness Ave (Phase 4). The construction activity is within the travel lanes adjacent to the median and also inside the median area. The work will be ongoing for approximately four weeks. Once completed, construction will begin on the outside travel lanes and parking lanes.

TRAFFIC INFORMATION

Artesia Blvd: Crenshaw Blvd to Van Ness Ave

Traffic is reduced to one lane in each direction on a 24-hr basis between Crenshaw Blvd and Van Ness Ave for approximately 8 weeks. The eastbound left-turn lane from Artesia Blvd onto northbound Van Ness Ave is now closed. The westbound left-turn lane from Artesia Blvd onto southbound Crenshaw Blvd soon will be closed. Left-turns will be prohibited during construction.



Left turns into and out of Atkinson Ave, Wilkie Ave, Ardath Ave and Casimir Ave will be prohibited during construction.

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

Reconstruction is 95% complete at Prairie Ave Intersection!

Reconstruction of the intersection of Artesia Blvd and Prairie Ave has been ongoing since February 9. Work progressed quickly, despite some rainy days. The contractor worked on two Saturdays in March to expedite the work.

As of Wednesday March 17 the majority of new paving was completed and several travel lanes re-opened. The final surface paving will be placed later in March. The work will be scheduled on a Saturday morning to minimize impacts to residents, businesses and commuters. A Notice will be mailed in advance of this work.
