Construction to Begin on Artesia Boulevard !

The City of Torrance has hired Sully-Miller Contracting Company of Anaheim to rehabilitate Artesia Boulevard from Hawthorne Boulevard to Western Avenue. Improvements will include pavement reconstruction; roadway widening just east of Prairie Ave. and at Western Ave.; repair of damaged curb, gutter and sidewalk; storm drains; traffic signal upgrades; signing & striping; and new median and parkway landscaping.

Construction activities will begin the week of July 7th. The first order of work is to repair damaged curb, gutter and sidewalk along the parking lanes. Next, the reconstruction of the pavement and medians will start at Hawthorne Blvd and progress towards Western Ave. Please be advised that traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction. Delays are expected.

A community meeting will be held on Thursday, July 10, 2003, at 7:00 p.m. at the Katy Geissert Civic Center Library, Main Meeting Room, 3301 Torrance Blvd.

Construction is scheduled for completion in summer 2004.

As is the case with all major street construction projects, some inconveniences will be encountered. Our project team is dedicated to minimizing inconveniences. Please do your part by observing all traffic controls and parking restrictions. This will help to expedite the construction schedule and provide a safe work area.
