Response to Bidder Requests for Information

For Request for Proposals (RFP) B2014-26 Bid for Construction of Four Vertical Landfill Gas Wells (Drilling and Installation) located at the City Services Facility at 20500 Madrona Avenue

The following are responses to Requests for Information received during the pre-bid meeting on May 28th and via email.

BIDDER REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION

1. Who will bring the dirt to the work area?
Response – City will bring dirt however the Contractor is required to screen it to meet the specification as stated in the specifications. Screening may be done near the stockpile at a location approved by the City.
2. What are the working hours?
Response – Working hours are 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM. Note that all drilling spoils must be loaded into the roll-off provided by the City and covered prior to the end of the work day.
3. Who is providing the well casing?
Response – Per the specifications, the Contractor shall provide the solid and perforated well casing.
4. What is the dimension on the over-excavation?
Response – The City will perform the saw cutting and replacement of asphalt.
5. What survey is required and by who?
Response – The City's Consultant will provide survey.
6. Who is controlling traffic and access to the work area?
Response – The City will barricade the work areas and control traffic.
7. Well #2 is shown located in the field between a curb stop and the fence line. There is insufficient room for equipment and the borehole without impacting the fence. How is this to be addressed?
Response – The City will re-mark the drilling location roughly 25 feet north of the current proposed location to stay clear of the fence and the parking space.

8. How is the well to be left once completed?

Response – Contractor shall leave the well with a 2-foot stickup with a PVC slip cap screwed to the casing per the construction drawings.

9. The SCAQMD permit to constructs condition 4, "During well drilling, an approved emissions control box shall be placed over the well hole to collect landfill gas. The collected gas shall be directed to an operating carbon adsorption system which has a valid permit issued by the AQMD, and which has sufficient capacity to remove odors."
- Can you please provide an approved system and vendor or minimum design criteria for use on this project including emission control box, system scfm, blower requirements, AQMD approved carbon media and quantity of media?
 - Also will we need to apply for an AQMD permit to operate or is there a standard system that meet the AQMD requirement?

Response – The SCAQMD has waived the vacuum box requirement due to the age of waste and unlikeliness of positive pressure during drilling. This does not relieve the contractor from taking all necessary safety precautions and to limit emissions during drilling.

10. The detail calls for a Landtec WBS100 well bore seal. The standard well bore seal has a 10' x 10' skirt and a 36" sleeve to attach to the pipe. The plan shows the wellbore seal 2' below the surface. Even if we push the sleeve all the way down, it may be in conflict with the new wellhead location and vault.
- Can you clarify if we are digging a 10' by 10' by 2' deep hole around each of the wells?
 - One of the bore holes was near a fence and curb, will the City remove and replace the Asphalt, fence and curb?

Response – a. City will saw cut 5 square feet of asphalt. Contractor shall excavate to 3.5 feet below ground surface. Wells should be completed to 3 feet below ground surface with 2 feet of stickup. Borehole should be drilled eccentric to the excavation at roughly 14 inches from the sidewall to allow for installation of the wellhead in the concrete vault by others.

Contractor shall trim the skirt of the bore seal to fit the excavated area and shall trim the vertical sleeve as not to extend beyond 12 inches above the upper bentonite seal.

Response – b. See response to question 7 above.

11. The city is providing the soil for backfill. The contractor is required to screen the material if it does not meet the 3" minus specification.
- Can you verify if the material requires us to screen it?
 - If so can we screen it onsite and do we need to permit the screen?

Response – City will haul the soil backfill from the onsite stockpile however the Contractor is required to screen it to meet the specification as stated in the specifications. Screening may be done near the stockpile at a location approved by the City.

12. Water for construction. They said there are several fire hydrants onsite for us to use.
- a. Will we need to provide a water meter or is there another source?

Response – Contractor will not need to provide a water meter.

13. Survey. They mentioned that the contractor would need to provide survey locations of each well installed.
- a. Can you provide survey control points and detailed survey requirements?
 - b. Or will the city be doing the survey?

Response – The City's consultant will provide survey.

14. What is the dimension on the over-extension? Will the pipe come in those dimensions?

Response – Stickup shall be 2 feet. Contractor shall provide well pipe per the specifications.


