Torrance Centennial Committee Invites Organizations to Submit Events for Inclusion in the 2012 Celebration

Torrance, Calif., September 7, 2010 – The City of Torrance's Centennial Committee invites Torrance-based organizations to participate in the City's Centennial Celebration in 2012. In addition to official events being planned, Torrance-based organizations may participate in the year-long celebration by submitting their respective events for consideration as part of the official Centennial Celebration. The application for consideration is now available online at www.TorranceCA.Gov/Centennial.

Events must not be in conflict with other approved Centennial or standing community events. Official kick-off and culminating Centennial events will take place in October 2011 and October 2012. Organizations may check the Centennial website and the Torrance Events Calendar (www.TorranceCA.Gov/events) for any conflicts. Schedule of events will be posted as dates are set. For consideration, events must be open to public, be family-oriented (G-Rated), show a demonstrated link to the City of Torrance, and acknowledge local or group history; a host organization may interject its own history or the event's history.

Overall, submitted events must help meet the Centennial Committee's mission – “to educate, celebrate, and commemorate the 100 years of Torrance.” Priority will be given to events involving Torrance residents. Applications will be reviewed on a first-come/first-served basis.

Torrance's Centennial Celebration will commemorate the City's first 100 years with fun-filled and education events. Planning is being spearheaded by the Torrance Centennial Committee.
