

**PROJECT FACT SHEET  
JUNE 30, 2002**

**Q: What work does the Crenshaw Blvd. Rehabilitation Project include?**

A: This project includes:

- Roadway reconstruction and re-pavement
- Replacement of displaced curb and gutter, sidewalk and driveways
- Replacement of trees causing damage
- Replacement of centerline median barrier
- Parkway landscaping improvements
- Construction of new curb ramps

**Q: What is the construction schedule?**

A: Phase I construction is expected to start on January 2, 2003 and to be completed by April 1, 2003.

A: Phase II to be scheduled

**Q: What are the hours of construction?**

A: Normal construction hours are from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. No construction work will take place on holidays.

**Q: How will traffic be affected?**

A: Two lanes of traffic will be open in each direction with occasional reduction to one lane in each direction as needed during the day. Traffic delays are expected and it is recommended that alternate routes be used to avoid the construction area.

**Q: Will access to my driveway be affected?**

A: Driveways to be replaced will require closure for 5 days to allow the new concrete to cure. Otherwise, access to driveways will be maintained except for short periods during the day as

needed for street construction. The contractor will notify those affected by extended driveway closures.

**Q: How much is this project going to cost and how will it be funded?**

A: The total project construction cost is approximately \$1.8 Million.

**Q: Who do we call if we have questions?**
