MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, August 10th, 1931, and was called to order at 7:45 P. M. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Trustees: Smith, Steiner and Dennis.

Absent: Trustees: Bell and Nelson.

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from the South Bay Distributors, 901 Spencer Street, Gardena, California, under date of August 10th, 1931, addressed to the City Council, and making application for a permit to install a twenty-two thousand (22,000) gallon gasoline tank on 24463 Hawthorne Boulevard, WALTERIA.

Trustee Steiner moved that the permit be granted if the tank be erected to comply with the specifications demanded by the City Engineer.

Trustee Smith seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

After some discussion on the question of compensation insurance for the men who are to work under the Los Angeles County Welfare Association, Trustee Smith moved that the City Clerk be instructed to reimburse the proper party for the compensation insurance necessary.

Trustee Smith seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

Trustee Smith moved that the City Clerk write to the County, notifying them that the portion of Lomita which was annexed to the City of Torrance, be removed from the County Light and Fire Protection Assessment District as said Districts are now taxable by the City of Torrance.
