MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance held for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on the tentative report prepared by the Council for zoning certain portions of the City of Torrance in accordance with Act 994 of Deering's General Laws of California (1923) Part 1, Page 369 (Statutes of 1917, page 1419) as amended, in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, November 24th., 1931. The meeting was called to order at 7:40 P. M. by Clerk Bartlett who stated that it was customary for the board to appoint one of the members chairman to act during the absence of the Mayor.

Councilman Smith moved that Councilman Steiner act as temporary chairman of the Board.

Councilman Bell seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Steiner then took the chair.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll and the following Councilmen responded: Councilmen: Bell, Smith and Steiner.

Absent: Councilmen: Nelson and Dennis.

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from the County of Los Angeles, Board of Supervisors under date of November 19, 1931, addressed to the Hon. John Dennis, referring to a petition from residents of WALTERIA in regard to the Dicalite dust nuisance. The Clerk was instructed to forward copy of this letter to the WALTERIA Chamber of Commerce. Chairman Steiner ordered letter be filed.

A communication dated November 20, 1931, was read by Clerk Bartlett, signed by residents and property owners on Cedar Street, requesting that trees on both sides of Cedar Street be topped.

Councilman Smith moved Street Superintendent be instructed to trim all trees in the City requiring trimming at this time.

Councilman Bell seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES: COUNCILMEN: Bell, Smith and Steiner
 NOES: " None.
 ABSENT: " Nelson and Dennis.

Chairman Steiner stated that since it was the object of this meeting to conduct a public hearing on the tentative report for zoning the City, submitted at the last regular meeting, the meeting was now open for discussion of this report.

Councilman Bell moved that this tentative report be submitted to the Council at its next regular meeting as the final report of the Council.

Councilman Smith seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Smith moved that the meeting be adjourned.

Councilman Bell seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 7:50 P. M.
