MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TORRANCE.

A Special Meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, March 10th., 1932, and was called to order at 10 o'clock A.M. by Mayor Dennis.

Mayor Dennis stated that the meeting had been called for the purpose of considering the adoption of a motion instructing the City Attorney to prepare a complaint to the Railroad Commission of the State of California. This being a specially called meeting the regular order of business is hereby dispensed with.

The following Councilmen were present: COUNCILMEN: Bell, Smith, Steiner and Dennis. Absent: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Smith moved that the City Attorney be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to prepare a formal complaint against the reasonableness of the rate or charge granted the Torrance Water, Light and Power Company for water sold by said Company to consumers in the City of Torrance; and to file same with the Railroad Commission of the State of California. Councilman Bell seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Bell, Smith, Steiner and Dennis. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Steiner moved that the meeting be adjourned.

Councilman Bell seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 10:20 A.M.
