MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chamber at Torrance, California, November 9th., 1932, and was called to order at 7:45 P.M. by Mayor Klusman.

The following Councilmen were present: COUNCILMEN: Conner, Hitchcock and Klusman. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Ludlow and Wright.

Councilman Conner moved that the minutes of the regular meeting of October 25th., 1932, be adopted. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Conner moved that the minutes of the special meeting of October 27th., 1932, be adopted. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Councilman Hitchcock requested that funds be allocated to purchase rock and oil for the improvement of a portion of Brooks Street in the McDonald Tract as this street could not be traveled in rainy weather. Councilman Hitchcock moved that \$160.00 be appropriated for the cost of material to be used in this work. The motion was seconded by Councilman Conner and duly carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Conner, Hitchcock and Klusman. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Ludlow and Wright.

It was called to the attention of the Council by Engineer Leonard that a request had been made by Mrs. Collins of the Torrance Relief Society that some galvanized iron previously used as fence around the Ball Park be donated to the Relief Society with which to construct small houses or shelters to accommodate some families now living in tents, the structures to be erected outside of the City of Torrance. It was moved by Councilman Hitchcock and seconded by Councilman Conner that the request of the Torrance Relief Society referred to be granted. The motion was duly carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Conner, Hitchcock and Klusman. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Ludlow and Wright.

Councilman Conner moved that warrants be drawn for all bills properly audited. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Conner, Hitchcock and Klusman. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Ludlow and Wright.

Motion to adjourn was made by Councilman Hitchcock, seconded by Councilman Conner and carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 8:00 P.M.
