MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING

A Special Meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chamber at Torrance, California, January 31st., 1933, and was called to order at 3:00 P.M. by Mayor Klusman.

Mayor Klusman stated the meeting was called for the purpose of considering the adoption of a Resolution requesting that the County of Los Angeles allocate funds to the city.

OUT OF ANY FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR SUCH PURPOSE,  
ALLOCATE TO THE CITY OF TORRANCE THE SUM OF  
\$2400.00.

Councilman Ludlow moved that Resolution No. 556 be adopted. Councilman Hitchcock, seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Conner, Hitchcock, Ludlow, Wright and Klusman. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.
