MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED MEETING

CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned meeting of an adjourned meeting of an adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chamber at Torrance, California, June 21st., 1933, and was called to order at 4:30 P.M. by Mayor Klusman.

The following Councilmen were present: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Ludlow, Wright and Klusman. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Conner.

At this time a recess was taken to await the arrival of Councilman Conner.

Councilman Conner arrived at 4:47 P.M.

This being an adjourned meeting, the regular order of business was suspended.

Auditor Rambo reported that he had made thorough inquiry relative to the possibilities of financing the water bonds through the new Government Industrial Rehabilitation Fund. After some discussion with reference to advisability of changing the Bond Ordinance, Attorney Jensen stated the Ordinance could be changed at a later date if it became necessary.

Councilman Ludlow moved that we instruct the City Clerk to have the necessary bonds printed under the original agreement. Councilman Wright seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Conner, Hitchcock, Ludlow, Wright and Klusman. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Clerk Bartlett read three estimates for the printing of the bonds:

Jeffries Banknote Company	-	\$281.50
Neuner Printing & Lithograph Co.	-	286.50
Automatic Printing Company	-	275.00

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the Automatic Printing Company be authorized to print the bonds. Councilman Conner seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Conner, Hitchcock, Ludlow, Wright and Klusman. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Conner stated the American Legion is planning to stage an outdoor card game and street entertainment the night of August 5th., and would like permission to rope off one block on Sartori between Marcelina and El Prado at that time. Upon motion by Councilman Conner, seconded by Councilman Hitchcock, and carried unanimously, permission to rope off this block was granted.

Councilman Ludlow moved that the meeting be adjourned. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 5:40 P.M.
