MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the City Hall, Torrance, California, on Friday, June 28th., 1935.

Meeting was called to order by City Clerk Bartlett at 4:15 P.M.

A recess was declared to await the arrival of Councilman Hitchcock and Mayor Ludlow. Councilman Hitchcock arrived 4:25 P.M. Mayor Ludlow arrived 4:31 P.M.

City Clerk Bartlett called the roll. Those answering present were Councilmen: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. Absent: Councilmen: None.

Mayor Ludlow stated the last meeting had been adjourned to this date for the purpose of considering the adoption of a resolution and an ordinance calling a bond election, and called for a report from the City Attorney. Attorney Rippy said he had prepared the resolution and ordinance except naming precincts and appointing election board, and there was a question as to how the P.W.A. would want this handled. City Clerk Bartlett stated he believed the Attorney for P.W.A. should be consulted before any proceedings were started. Attorney Rippy was instructed to consult with P.W.A. Attorney and report at a meeting Monday, July 1st.

Councilman Tolson reported that he had talked with Miss Meredith of the County Recreation Department with reference to Mr. Schmidt, Playground Supervisor of Walteria Playground, and Miss Meredith stated that the city could pay Mr. Schmidt 35% of his salary as now budgeted with the S.E.R.A. Mr. Tolson was requested to contact Mr. Schmidt and report at next meeting.

The gasoline contract for the fiscal year was discussed. Mayor Ludlow requested City Clerk Bartlett to get more estimates from the various oil companies and have them ready for action at next meeting.

The matter of obtaining deeds from the Kettler Estate in the Cabrillo-Eshelman improvement proceedings was discussed, and Attorney Rippy read Resolution No. 710 which had been adopted at the June 25th. meeting.

Councilman Tolson stated several improvements were to be made at the Municipal Park, the play ground is to be moved and extra equipment added, a wind break, incinerator and sinks built and gas plates installed. Councilman Tolson then moved \$1000.00 be appropriated for these improvements. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Stanger moved 1000 ft. 2½" Fire Hose be purchased. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, the record of vote is as follows: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Mayor Ludlow requested Street Superintendent Gascoigne to investigate the garbage collection expense.

Discussion as to the use of the city bus by the Recreation Department took place and it was decided they could use the bus two days a week for the next two months.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the meeting be adjourned to Monday, July 1st., 1935, at 4:30 P.M. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Mayor Ludlow declared the meeting adjourned at 5:55 P.M.
