MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting on September 20, 1935, at 4:45 P.M.

Mayor Ludlow called the meeting to order and stated that it had been called for the purpose of adopting a resolution referring to Damuth Condemnation Suit.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being: Councilmen: Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. Absent: Councilman Hitchcock, Councilman Hitchcock having previously signed consent to meeting.

Clerk Bartlett presented and read in full:
