MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a special meeting in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Torrance, California, October 3, 1935.

Mayor Ludlow called the meeting to order at 4:30 P.M.

Mayor Ludlow announced that the meeting was called for the purpose of adopting a resolution to appropriate funds to help defray travelling expenses incurred by the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors in sending representatives to Washington, D.C., in the matter of P.W.A. applications.
