MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED
REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an adjourned regular meeting in the City Hall, Torrance, California, on Wednesday, October 23rd., 1935.

Mayor Ludlow called the meeting to order at 4:30 P.M.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those Councilmen answering present being: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Klusman.

Being an adjourned meeting the regular order of business was suspended.

Mr. Eisen of the firm of Walker and Eisen, Architects, was present and submitted plans and specifications for the proposed municipal buildings. After considerable discussion, Councilman Hitchcock moved that the plans and specifications of the proposed City Hall, Auditorium and Library Buildings be approved.
