MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED MEETING
OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an adjourned meeting of an adjourned regular meeting in the Council Chambers, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Thursday evening, November 21, 1935.

Mayor Ludlow called the meeting to order at 7:45 P.M.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. Absent: Councilman Hitchcock.

Mayor Ludlow announced that due to this being an adjourned meeting, the regular order of business would be dispensed with.

Attorney Rippy presented and read in full:

Councilman Stanger moved that Resolution No. 775 be adopted. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Hitchcock.

Attorney Rippy presented and read in full:

Councilman Stanger moved that Resolution No. 776 be adopted. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Hitchcock.

Attorney Rippy presented and read in full:

RESOLUTION NO. 777

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TORRANCE, AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF CONTRACT
WITH FRED W. WEBER

Councilman Stanger moved that Resolution No. 777 be adopted. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Klusman, Stanger, Tolson and Ludlow. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMAN: Hitchcock.

Clerk Bartlett stated that there was an application to remove a pepper tree at 1904 Arlington Avenue. Councilman Klusman moved that the request be granted. Councilman Stanger seconded the motion, which was carried.

Street Superintendent Gascoigne reported that he had been requested to remove eucalyptus trees on El Prado. Councilman Klusman moved that the request be granted. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried.

A short recess was declared between 7:53 P.M. and 8:00 P.M.

At 8 o'clock Mayor Ludlow instructed the Clerk to open the sealed bids on the municipal buildings.

The following bids were read:

Public Library Building - Bid A - \$23,267.00
City Hall, Jail & Garages - Bid A - \$56,110.00

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from R. J. Daum, stating that if awarded the contract for the City Hall and Library buildings, \$700 would be deducted from the City Hall; that if awarded the contract for the City Hall and Assembly buildings, \$800 would be deducted from the City Hall; that if awarded the contract for both the Assembly Hall and Library buildings, \$550 would be deducted from the Assembly Hall; and that if the contract was awarded for all three buildings, \$1200 would be deducted from the City Hall.

A communication from Duff & Vandenhooogen stated that if the contract was awarded for all three buildings, \$6000 would be deducted; and if contract awarded for any two of the buildings, \$3000 would be deducted.

Councilman Stanger moved that the bids be referred to the Architects, the City Engineer and the City Attorney for checking and report to the City Council at its regular meeting to be held Tuesday, November 26, 1935 at 7:45 P.M. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried.

Clerk Bartlett announced that the regular meeting of November 26th. would adjourn to Friday, November 29th, for the purpose of opening bids on bonds.

Upon motion of Councilman Tolson, seconded by Councilman Stanger, the meeting adjourned at 8:35 P.M.
