MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a special meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, Tuesday, June 16, 1936 at 4:30 P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Stanger.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being

A recess was declared, and the meeting reconvened at 4:50 P.M.
