MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED  
REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY  
COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an adjourned regular meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California on Tuesday, September 1, 1936 at 4:30 P.M.

Mayor Stanger called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. Absent: Councilmen: None.

The regular order of business was suspended.

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from City Attorney Rippy regarding the proposals covering collection and disposal of garbage. Councilman Tolson moved that all bids be rejected. Councilman Powell seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Attorney Rippy presented and read in full:

Councilman Hitchcock moved that Resolution No. 1034 $\frac{1}{2}$  be adopted. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Attorney Rippy presented and read in full:

COVERING WATER LINE ON GARDENA BOULEVARD

Councilman McGuire moved that Resolution No. 1035 be adopted. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

The City Engineer reported that it would be necessary to provide an extension for six culverts along Cedar Avenue for the protection of the public, as well as to provide an overhead light at 190th Street at the intersection of Cedar Avenue; also to paint stripes on two telephone poles considered a hazard at this intersection. He stated that the estimate would be furnished at the next meeting.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the City Engineer be instructed to proceed with the work and to report later as to cost. Councilman McGuire seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman Tolson moved that not more than \$200.00 be appropriated for the reception of Louis Zamperini in Torrance. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Mayor Stanger asked Mr. Eisen if he had any definite information on the proposed Administration and Fire Station Buildings.

Mr. Eisen said that the applications had been approved by Mr. Ickes' office and that it was 99% certain that the Presidential order would be forthcoming.

Mayor Stanger called attention to the authorization by the Council that the City Engineer contact the architects with reference to the plans, and the Engineer reported that in his opinion the architects should be authorized to prepare detailed drawings for submission to the Council for final approval and that the details be sufficiently worked out to avoid, as much as possible, change orders in connection with the progress of the work.

Mr. Eisen stated that plans would be submitted before the next meeting.

Clerk Bartlett stated that the Park Department wished to purchase a mowing machine.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that an appropriation not to exceed \$165.00 be made for the purchase of a mowing machine for the Park Department. Councilman Tolson seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell, Tolson and Stanger. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

At 4:55 P.M., upon motion of Councilman Hitchcock, seconded by Councilman Powell, the meeting adjourned.
