MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED MEETING

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an adjourned meeting of an adjourned regular meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Monday, March 22, 1937 at 4:45 P.M.

Mayor Tolson called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Deininger, Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell and Tolson. Absent: Councilmen: None.

Clerk Bartlett read the call of the meeting, which was "for the purpose of canvassing the vote of the Charter Election held March 16, 1937."

The absentee ballot was declared to be "No."

COMMUNICATIONS

Communication from Walteria requesting a light at 101 and Newton Highways.

After some discussion, Councilman Powell moved that the matter be turned over to the Chairman of the Street Department. Councilman Deininger seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Deininger, Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Councilman McGuire brought up the matter of the mosquito situation. It was decided to take the matter up with the Health Department.

Mr. Rippey stated that the Damuth judgment amounted to \$328.80, and the amount due the Title Insurance Company \$125.00, total amount \$453.80, which amount must be paid by April 19, 1937.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that this amount be paid. Councilman Deininger seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Deininger, Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Clerk Bartlett announced that the grant money for the Administration Building is due Wednesday, March 24.
