MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an adjourned regular meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Monday, August 30, 1937 at 4:45 p.m.

Mayor Tolson called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Deininger, Hitchcock, Powell and Tolson. Absent: Councilman: McGuire.

Clerk Bartlett announced the purpose of the adjourned meeting, which was in anticipation of further change orders, or that others may not have been approved. He stated, however, that approval of all change orders had been received and no new ones were anticipated.

After some discussion, Councilman Deininger made a motion that not to exceed \$75.00 per person be appropriated to cover expenses of the trip to San Jose for those attending the State League Meeting.

Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Deininger, Hitchcock, McGuire, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: McGuire.

Councilman Hitchcock made a motion that not to exceed \$300.00 be appropriated for a Home Light Pump for the Street Department.


Councilman Deininger seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Deininger, Hitchcock, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: McGuire.

After some discussion about tree removals, trees at 1618 Amapola, 1622 Amapola and 2103 Arlington were referred to the committee for investigation.

Councilman Powell asked Clerk Bartlett to notify the City Electrician again that the lights around the rest rooms at the Municipal Park need attention.

Councilman Hitchcock suggested that eucalyptus trees be planted along Cedar Street during the rainy season. No action was taken.

At 5:02 p.m., upon motion of Councilman Deininger, seconded by Councilman Hitchcock, the meeting adjourned.
