MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED MEETING
OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an adjourned meeting of an adjourned regular meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Wednesday, August 31, 1938 at 4:30 P.M.

Mayor Tolson called the meeting to order.

There being no quorum present, a recess was declared.

The meeting reconvened at 4:40 P.M.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Hitchcock, McGuire, Murray, Powell and Tolson. Absent: Councilmen: None.

The regular order of business was suspended.

WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS

A communication was read from Los Angeles County Board of Health regarding the application of V. Chambers, 4813 West 171st Street, to operate a hog farm at said address. It was the Board's recommendation that the request be denied.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the Board's recommendation be accepted. Councilman Murray seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

A communication was read from L.C. Luck requesting the removal of two trees on his property. The matter was referred to the Street Committee for further consideration.

A communication was read from the Moyle Oil Company desiring to lease property on which the city dump is located for oil and gas development.

After some discussion, Councilman Hitchcock moved that the matter be referred to the City Attorney for further investigation. Councilman Murray seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

A communication was read from L.M. Ford, County Supervisor of Los Angeles County, referring to the Alondra Park assessment district. It was suggested that the Council make every effort to support the writer in his fight against the Board for this district.

A bill in amount of \$80.41 for fire equipment was presented by The General Fire Truck Corporation.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the bill be paid. Councilman Murray seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Murray, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Clerk Bartlett stated that six globes on lower Cota Ave, near Maricopa Place had been broken by boys using sling shots. The City Electrician recommended that the globes be replaced with unbreakable ones, at a cost of \$10.00 per globe.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that \$60.00 be appropriated for the purchase of unbreakable globes. Councilman McGuire seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Murray, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.


Clerk Bartlett presented for final reading and read in full:

ORDINANCE NO. 307

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, CALLING AND PROVIDING FOR AND GIVING NOTICE OF A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, ON THE 20th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1938, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY PROPOSITIONS TO INCUR BONDED INDEBTEDNESSES BY SAID CITY FOR CERTAIN MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENTS.

Councilman McGuire moved that Ordinance No. 307 be adopted for final reading. Councilman Murray seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Murray, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

After some discussion on the Annual Convention of Pacific Coast Fire Chief's Association in Salt Lake City, September 19 to 22, 1938, Councilman Hitchcock moved that the Director of Public Safety and the Mayor be authorized to attend said Convention with all expenses paid. Councilman Murray seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Hitchcock, McGuire, Murray, Powell and Tolson. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None. At 5:07 P.M., upon motion of Councilman McGuire, seconded by Councilman Hitchcock, the meeting adjourned.
