MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR  
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Thursday, July 24, 1941 at 4:47 P.M.

Mayor McGuire called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. Absent: Councilmen: Murray.

The meeting recessed to await arrival of Councilman Murray, Mayor McGuire instructing Clerk Bartlett to telephone Councilman Murray, which was done, Clerk Bartlett announcing that Mr. Murray will arrive shortly. At 4:55 P.M., Councilman Murray telephoned a message that he would be unable to attend the meeting, at which time the meeting reconvened.

Clerk Bartlett presented and read title to:

RESOLUTION NO. 1484

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF TORRANCE AUTHORIZING MAYOR TO SIGN AND  
CITY CLERK TO ATTEST THE DEDICATION CERTIFI-  
CATE ON MAP OF PROPOSED TRACT NO. 12881.

Councilman Babcock moved that Resolution No. 1484 be adopted. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Murray.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that an appropriation of not to exceed \$325.00 be made for construction of curbs and gutters on Plaza Del Amo from Border Avenue to alley west of Andreo Avenue.

Councilman Babcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Murray.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that an appropriation of not to exceed \$240.00 be made for construction of curbs and gutters on Andreo Avenue from Plaza Del Amo to alley south. Councilman Babcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Murray.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that an appropriation of not to exceed \$240.00 be made for construction of curbs and gutters on Cabrillo Avenue from Plaza Del Amo to alley south. Councilman Powell seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Murray.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that an appropriation of not to exceed \$120.00 be made for construction of curbs and gutters on Border Avenue from Plaza Del Amo to alley south. Councilman Babcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Babcock, Hitchcock, Powell and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Murray.

Clerk Bartlett suggested that appropriation requests be submitted to the City Clerk's office in order that a program can be prepared in advance of the meeting. Mayor McGuire requested that this procedure be followed in the future.

Clerk Bartlett announced that a meeting will be held August 4, 1941, at 7:45 P.M. for the purpose of canvassing the votes of the special election to be held July 29, 1941, advising that this is in accordance with the Election Laws of the State of California, and that the entire Council is required to be present at the meeting.

Engineer Jain was instructed to have the Planning Commission Meeting scheduled for August 4, 1941 postponed to August 11, 1941.

At 5:03 P.M., upon motion of Councilman Hitchcock, seconded by Councilman Babcock, the meeting adjourned.
