MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR  
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, August 19, 1941 at 4:45 P.M.

Mayor McGuire called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Babcock, Hitchcock and McGuire. Absent: Councilmen: None.

Being an Adjourned Meeting, the regular order of business was dispensed with.

A communication was read from the City of Los Angeles Board of Public Utilities and Transportation, regarding application of City of Torrance for Permit Authorizing Operation of Municipally-owned Bus Line in Los Angeles, advising that the City Council will be granted a hearing before the Board with reference to the objections of the City of Torrance to the opinion and order of the Board tentatively adopted August 5, 1941 with reference to the above entitled matter, said hearing to be held August 22, 1941 at 10:00 A.M.

Referred to Attorney McCall.

A communication was read from The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, inquiring whether the Governing Body of the City of Torrance elects to pay out of municipal funds all or any portion of the amount of tax which will otherwise be levied upon property within the City of Torrance, known as the Metropolitan Water District Tax, for the current fiscal year.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California be advised that the City of Torrance does not desire to pay out of municipal funds all or any portion of the amount of tax which will otherwise be levied upon property within the City of Torrance, said tax known as the Metropolitan Water District Tax, for the current fiscal year. Councilman Babcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Babcock, Hitchcock and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.


Councilman Babcock suggested that the newly appointed Civil Service Board should be instructed to meet and form its organization for performance of duties. Councilman Hitchcock asked whether or not two separate Boards are in existence and was advised that the new Board consists of five members, two being members of the other Board.

Councilman Babcock moved that the City Clerk be instructed to notify members of the newly appointed Civil Service Board to meet August 25, 1941 at 8:00 P.M., in the City Hall, for the purpose of forming its organization for the performance of duties. Councilman Hitchcock seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

At 4:54 P.M., upon motion of Councilman Babcock, seconded by Councilman Hitchcock, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday evening, August 20, 1941 at 7:45 P.M.
