MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED
REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Tuesday, September 16, 1941 at 7:45 P.M.

Mayor McGuire called the meeting to order.

Clerk Bartlett called the roll, those answering present being Councilmen: Babcock, Hitchcock and McGuire.

All persons present in the Council Chamber, Saluted the Flag:

Mayor McGuire announced the purpose of the meeting, being to canvass the returns of the Special Municipal Election held September 10, 1941.

Clerk Bartlett proceeded to open sealed envelopes No. 3 containing tally lists for the sixteen (16) City of Torrance precincts, which lists were handed to the City Council.

The City Council then proceeded to canvass the votes.

Clerk Bartlett opened sealed absentee ballots, removed the numbers from the upper left hand corner, marked the Precinct numbers on the reverse side of folded ballots, and deposited ballots in locked ballot box.

The box was then unlocked, sixteen ballots removed and results read as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 1497

RESOLUTION DECLARING RESULTS OF SPECIAL
MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF
TORRANCE SEPTEMBER 10, 1941.

Councilman Hitchcock moved that Resolution No. 1497 be adopted. Councilman Babcock seconded the motion, which was carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Babcock, Hitchcock, and McGuire. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: None.

Clerk Bartlett then administered the oath of office of Councilmen to Mr. George V. Powell and Mr. Kenneth H. Kail, who took their positions at the Council table.

Clerk Bartlett, the City Attorney and the City Council congratulated Councilmen Powell and Kail.

Councilman Powell was invited to speak, which invitation he accepted, declaring that he will be found to be the same as in the past.

Councilman Kail also accepted the invitation to speak, declaring his intentions to serve his office to the best of his ability.

At 8:11 P.M., upon motion of Councilman Hitchcock, seconded by Councilman Babcock, the meeting adjourned.
