MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR  
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in an Adjourned Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, at 2:00 o'clock p.m., Mayor Sherfey presiding. The following Councilmen responded to roll call: Drale, Haggard, Jackson, Powell and Sherfey. Also present were City Attorney Smith, City Manager Stevens and City Clerk Bartlett.

All persons present participated in the salute to the Flag.

This being an Adjourned Regular Meeting, the regular order of business was dispensed with.

Clerk Bartlett read the following recommendations of City Manager Stevens:

AWARD OF CONTRACTS:

1. That the bid of George M. Green in the amount of \$1,525.00 per month, for the collection and disposal of garbage and non-combustible rubbish, be accepted for a term of two (2) years and all other bids be rejected.
2. That the bid of the Lund Company in the amount of \$5,007.59 per year, for Comprehensive Liability, including Property Damage, be accepted and all other bids be rejected.
3. That the bid of the Torrance General Insurance Agency in the amount of \$588.57 per year, for Fire, Theft and Comprehensive insurance on the City Fleet, be accepted and all other bids be rejected.
4. That the bid of Logan R. Cotton and Bruce Brown in the amount of \$1,150.00, for auditing the books and accounts of the General City Government and Bus Department for the fiscal year 1949-50, be accepted.

Councilman Jackson moved that Council concur with recommendations of City Manager Stevens regarding Award of Contracts 1, 2, 3 and 4. Motion, seconded by Councilman Powell, carried unanimously by roll call vote.

5. That the bid of the Torrance Herald in the amount of \$1.56 per column inch for the first publication and \$1.20 per column inch for subsequent publications of the same notice, for publishing the City's legal notices, ordinances, etc., be accepted.

Mayor Sherfey moved that the matter under Award of Contracts 5 be referred to the Council and City Attorney together with a representative of the Torrance Herald for further discussion. Motion, seconded by Councilman Powell, carried unanimously by roll call vote.

APPROPRIATIONS:

1. For the erection of a metal shop and office building, the sum of \$12,500.00. (From Unappropriated Reserve). This amount was tentatively appropriated at a previous Council Meeting.

Councilman Drale moved Council concur with recommendation of City Manager. Motion, seconded by Councilman Jackson, carried unanimously by roll call vote.

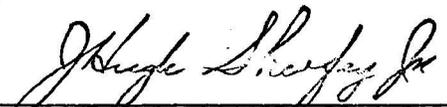
