ORDINANCE NO. 515


AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

Motion, seconded by Councilman Blount, carried by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Blount, Powell and Haggard. NAYS: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Drale and Spelman. Councilman Blount moved for the adoption of Ordinance No. 515 at its second and final reading. Motion, seconded by Councilman Powell, carried by the unanimous roll call vote of those present.
