MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF TORRANCE

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chamber of the City Hall on Thursday, December 14, 1950, at 4:28 p.m., Mayor Haggard presiding.

Those responding to roll call by City Clerk Bartlett were:  
COUNCILMEN: Blount, Powell and Haggard. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Drale and Spelman. Also present was City Manager Stevens.

This being a Special Meeting, the regular order of business was dispensed with and the Mayor announced the meeting was called for the purpose of approving Tract Map No. 15926, submitted by the American Land Company and Moss Construction Co., and any other business which might come before the Council.

City Clerk Bartlett read a letter from Mr. Patrick, Assistant to City Engineer, advising the Planning Commission, on December 13, 1950, had unanimously approved Tract Map No. 15926. ~~Councilman Powell moved the~~ Councilman Powell moved the Council concur in the recommendation and accept the Tract Map, with the provision that curbs, gutters and sidewalks be placed on 190th and Arlington and that the subdivider also put in pavement between existing street pavement and the gutter line. Motion, seconded by Councilman Blount, carried by unanimous roll call vote of those present.

Clerk Bartlett read a letter from James M. Hall accepting appointment as City Attorney, effective December 16, 1950. Councilman Blount moved the communication be accepted. Motion, seconded by Councilman Powell, carried.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 4:31 on motion of Councilman Powell, seconded by Councilman Blount.
