MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE TORRANCE CITY COUNCIL

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Monday, January 12, 1953, at 12:08 p.m., Mayor Schwab presiding.

Those responding to roll call by Deputy City Clerk Hallanger were: COUNCILMEN: Blount, Drale, Spelman and Schwab. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Benstead.

Mayor Schwab announced that this being a Special Meeting the regular order of business would be dispensed with, and stated that at a previous meeting there had been some discussion on the annexation of certain territory lying west of the city; that to date no official action had been taken, and that this meeting was called for the purpose of reading resolutions concerning the annexation of unincorporated territories.

Councilman Drale stated that it had been the policy of the City to give assistance to other communities in times of disaster, and moved that the City of Torrance offer its services and facilities, within reason, to the stricken City of Redondo Beach. Motion, seconded by Councilman Spelman, carried unanimously by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Blount, Drale, Spelman and Schwab. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Benstead.

Deputy City Clerk Hallanger read title to:

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO ANNEX CERTAIN UNINHABITED AND UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES CONTIGUOUS TO SAID CITY.

Councilman Blount moved to dispense with further reading of the Resolution. Motion, seconded by Councilman Drale, carried unanimously by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Blount, Drale, Spelman and Schwab. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Benstead. Councilman Blount moved for the adoption of Resolution No. 2345. Councilman Blount moved to dispense with further reading of the Resolution. Motion, seconded by Councilman Spelman, carried unanimously by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Blount, Drale, Spelman and Schwab. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Benstead.

Mayor Schwab asked for clarification of the resolutions as they appeared to be alike. He was advised that there are two resolutions affecting two different parcels of land.

Councilman Blount moved for the adoption of Resolution No. 2346. Motion, seconded by Councilman Spelman, carried unanimously by the following roll call vote: AYES: COUNCILMEN: Blount, Drale, Spelman and Schwab. NOES: COUNCILMEN: None. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Benstead.

At 12:12 p.m. Councilman Blount moved the meeting adjourn. Motion, seconded by Councilman Spelman, carried unanimously.
