MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE TORRANCE CITY COUNCIL

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Wednesday, April 22, 1953, at 8:10 p.m., Mayor Schwab presiding.

Those responding to roll call by Deputy City Clerk Hallanger were: COUNCILMEN: Benstead, Drale, Spelman and Schwab. ABSENT: COUNCILMEN: Blount. Also present were City Manager Stevens and City Attorney Hall.

Mayor Schwab announced as this was a Special Meeting the regular order of business would be dispensed with. Mayor Schwab stated the Special Meeting was held to re-approve Tract Map 16211 and requested City Manager Stevens' recommendations.

City Manager Stevens advised that at a former date the City Council had approved Tract Map 16211, which is in North Torrance and involved an exchange of a triangular piece of City property for a piece of sub-divider's property. After the Council had approved the Map and forwarded it to the County to be filed, it developed the former owners were required to sign the Map to permit recording. The signatures have now been obtained and the County

requires a re-approval of the Tract Map in order that the City Council's approval will be subsequent to the other approvals. City Manager Stevens recommended re-approval of Tract Map 16211 for the reasons stated.

Councilman Benstead moved to concur with the recommendations of City Manager Stevens for the re-approval of Tract Map 16211. Motion, seconded by Councilman Spelman, carried unanimously by roll call vote of those present.

At 8:15 p.m. Councilman Spelman moved the meeting adjourn. Motion, seconded by Councilman Drale, carried unanimously by those present.
