MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE TORRANCE CITY COULCIL

The City Council of the City of Torrance convened in a Special Meeting in the Council Chamber, City Hall, Torrance, California, on Wednesday, May 6, 1953, at 7:35 p.m., Mayor Schwab presiding.

Those responding to roll call by City Clerk Bartlett were:

Blount and Spelman. Also present were City Manager Stevens and  
City Attorney Hall.

Mayor Schwab announced as this was a Special Meeting the regular order of business would be dispensed with. He said this meeting was called to meet with the interested parties regarding Tract No. 19108, and for the Council to take action on this tract.

City Clerk Bartlett said he had a communication addressed to the City Council from Asst. to City Engineer Patrick referring to Tract No. 19108, which stated it has been impossible to arrive at a solution between the principals involved, as the case has gone to court and is still being tried as of this date.

Mr. Elsterman, Engineer for subdivider Henry C. Griswold, expressed Mr. Griswold's appreciation to the Council for calling this Special Meeting, and for all the consideration given him; however, due to the fact this case is still in court Mr. Elsterman requested that action on Tract No. 19108 be deferred for one week.

Mr. Donald Armstrong, representing the property owners on Earl Street, in this court case, joined Mr. Elsterman in his request.

Councilman Benstead moved that action on Tract No. 19108 be deferred to the regular Council meeting to be held May 12, 1953, at 8:00 p.m.

Motion, seconded by Councilman Drale, carried unanimously by those present.

At 7:45 p.m. Councilman Benstead moved the meeting adjourn. Motion, seconded by Councilman Drale, carried unanimously by those present.
