MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING
OF THE TORRANCE CITY COUNCIL

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The Torrance City Council convened in an adjourned regular meeting on Thursday, May 21, 1970, at 4:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at Torrance City Hall.

2. ROLL CALL:

Responding to roll call by City Clerk Coil were: Councilmen Brewster, Johnson, Sciarrotta, Surber, Uerkwitz, Wilson, and Mayor Miller. Absent: None.

Also present: City Manager Ferraro; City Clerk Coil.

3. DISPENSATION WITH REGULAR ORDER OF BUSINESS:

Councilman Sciarrotta MOVED to dispense with the regular order of business. His motion, seconded by Councilman Brewster, was unanimously approved by roll call vote.

4. TRIP TO PHOENIX, ARIZONA.

City Manager Ferraro advised that the requested information re: financing of the subject trip (agenda item #26, May 19, 1970) could not be obtained inasmuch as the utility company authorities in this regard were out of town.
