

MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

January 26, 1925.

An adjourned, regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, January 26, 1925, Clerk Bartlett calling the meeting to order at 8:30 p.m. in the absence of President Smith. The following Trustees were present: Brooks, Deininger and Torrence. Absent Fitzhugh and Smith.

Trustee Deininger moved that Mr. Brooks act as President pro tem. Trustee Torrence seconded the motion which was duly carried.
