

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE

Torrance, California,
July 6, 1925.

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, July 6, 1925, and was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by President Deininger. The following Trustees were present: Brooks, Smith and Deininger. Absent: Fitzhugh and Torrence.

The minutes of the regular meeting of June 15, 1925, were read and approved as read.

The minutes of the adjourned, regular meeting of June 29, 1925, were read and approved as read.

Trustee Brooks reported in the matter of the claim of Mr. Klusman as to paving of alleys that the committee agreed that nothing could be done now to reduce his assessment as no great injustice had been done; that if anything were done, it would open the way for all kinds of protests, so he thought the Board should stand pat.

On recommendation of the Street Superintendent and the Assistant Engineer, Trustee Brooks moved that a disc frame be purchased at a cost of \$300.00. Trustee Smith seconded the motion which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES; Trustees: Brooks, Smith and Deininger.

NOES; Trustees: None.

ABSENT; Trustees: Fitzhugh and Torrence.

Trustee Brooks moved that a set of discs for a disc frame be purchased at a cost of \$300.00. Trustee Smith seconded the motion which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES; Trustees: Brooks, Smith and Deininger.

NOES; Trustees: None.

ABSENT; Trustees: Fitzhugh and Torrence.

Trustee Brooks moved that a set of wheels and a 2-blade adjustable road drag be purchased at a cost of \$159.62. Trustee Smith seconded the motion which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES; Trustees: Brooks, Smith and Deininger.

NOES; Trustees: None.

ABSENT; Trustees: Fitzhugh and Torrence.

Mr. Hobson reported that the cost of material for the improvement of the aviation field would cost \$441.10; also that the P. E. officials were working out a plan for a spur track to supply the city yards.

Clerk Bartlett reported that the auditor was working on the books, and that he (Mr. Bartlett) intended to take a vacation starting Saturday the 11th and returning the 19th.

Mr. Gascoigne reported that they were fixing the road near the brick yard and suggested that the north side of Plaza Del Amo be improved so that trucks might be routed that side of the street so as not to have to pass the residences on the south side of the street, besides making more room for traffic.

Trustee Fitzhugh arrived at 8:40 p.m.

Trustee Smith introduced:

Mr. Hobson reported that, through misrepresentation, a house had been allowed to be built within a foot of the side line of the property; that the man owning the adjoining lot had been told by a

contractor that he must keep five feet from his side line; that this showed collusion to violate the building ordinance, and asked for advice as how to act.

It was the sense of the Board that the chief offender be cited to appear before the Board and make an explanation.

Trustee Fitzhugh moved that \$3232.85 be transferred from the General fund and allocated to the following street improvement sinking funds:

and that such funds be returned to the General fund as sufficient collections are made in the respective funds to which such sums are being transferred by this motion. Trustee Brooks seconded the motion which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

At 9:30 p.m., Trustee Smith moved to adjourn. Trustee Fitzhugh seconded the motion which was duly carried.
