MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

A special called meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, Jan. 31, 1928, and was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Conner, Raymond, Inman and Dennis. Absent: Wolfe.

The Mayor stated that as this was a special called meeting, the regular order of business would be dispensed with.

The Clerk read a letter from the Chamber of Commerce, containing the following resolution:

"RESOLVED, that the Chamber of Commerce approve the application of the Southern California Edison Company for a permit to install electrical transmission lines over certain streets in the City of Torrance and that this bureau recommend to the Municipal Authority of this community that such right-of-way be granted through the issuance of necessary franchises for the period of twenty-five (25) years, and be it further

"RESOLVED, that this action and recommendation is made after due consideration of all factors related to the subject tend to show conclusively that the physical changes and needs of this community at present will overcome any possible disadvantages which the installation of these power lines might occasion."

This letter was ordered filed.

After some discussion, it was moved by Trustee Inman, seconded by Trustee Raymond, that a permit be issued to the So. Cal. Edison Co. to construct a pole line from the easterly line of Cedar St. along the southerly line of Sonoma St. to the westerly line of the easterly portion of Madrid Avenue, thence northerly along such westerly line to a point 80' south of the first alley south of Redondo Blvd.; and a permit to construct an underground conduit along said westerly line of the easterly portion of Madrid Avenue from the last mentioned point to the first alley north of Redondo Blvd.; thence across the easterly portion of Madrid Avenue to the center line of the 110' Madrid Avenue; and that a permit be granted to them for construction of a pole line from said point northerly along the center line of 110' Madrid Avenue to the southerly line of Dominguez Street, thence easterly to a point near the westerly line of Cota St.; also commencing at a point on the northerly line of Dominguez St. near the extended northerly line of Sartori St., thence easterly along the northerly line of Dominguez St. to the westerly line of Arlington Avenue. This motion was unanimously carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES: Councilmen: Conner, Raymond, Inman and Dennis.
NOES: " None.
ABSENT: Wolfe.

Trustee Wolfe reported at 7:55 p.m.

There was a discussion of P. E. rights of way over crossings, and during the discussion Trustee Inman was excused, at 8:30 p.m. It was moved by Trustee Wolfe, seconded by Trustee Raymond, that the proposal of the Pacific Electric engineers, as to the division of cost of installing 35 crossings over Pacific Electric rights of

way in the City of Torrance, be approved. This motion was carried by the following roll call vote:

ABSENT:		Inman.

On motion by Trustee Wolfe, seconded by Trustee Conner, the meeting adjourned at 9:30 P. M.
