MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, Feb. 14, 1928, and was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Conner, Inman and Dennis. Absent; Raymond and Wolfe.

Reading of the minutes was postponed until the next regular meeting.

Engineer Leonard presented a map of Tract No. 10300 covering a proposed subdivision near the ocean front in the western portion of the City, explaining the details of same and recommending its approval.

Attorney Briney read:

RESOLUTION NO. 350

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Torrance that the map of Tract No. 10300, consisting of three sheets, this day presented, be, and the same is hereby, approved.

Trustee Conner moved that Resolution No. 350 be adopted as read and same filed in the office of the City Clerk. Trustee Inman seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

An extended discussion of the license ordinance followed, consisting chiefly of wholesale business.

Action on the application for permits for a pool hall and an open air second hand car market was postponed until the other Trustees were present.

Trustee Inman moved that all bills, properly audited, be paid. Trustee Conner seconded the motion which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:
