MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

A meeting of the City Council, as required by law, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, April 16, 1928, and was called to order at 7:45 P.M. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Conner, Inman, Raymond, Wolfe and Dennis. Absent: None.

The meeting being for the special purpose of canvassing the returns of the Municipal election held April 9, 1928, no order of business was followed.

Mayor Dennis ordered the canvassing of the returns of the election, as set forth above, to proceed.

After such had been made, Clerk Bartlett read:

RESOLUTION NO. 356.

Trustee Conner moved that Resolution No. 356 be adopted as read, and same filed in the office of the City Clerk. Trustee Raymond seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES: Trustees: Conner, Inman, Raymond, Wolfe and Dennis.
NOES: " None.
ABSENT: " None.

The Clerk administered the oath of office to Messrs. Dennis, Raymond and Maxwell; after which nominations for President of the Board were in order.

Trustee Raymond nominated Trustee Dennis as President of the Board for the ensuing two years--stating that Mr. Dennis had the time and the inclination to give Torrance a thoughtful administration.

Trustee Maxwell seconded the motion.

Trustee Inman put the question before the Board, which same was carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES: Trustees: Inman, Raymond, Wolfe and Maxwell.
NOES: " None.

Trustee Dennis did not vote.

Mayor Dennis started a speech by saying that he would do the best he could for the City, but was interrupted by some of the Board, one member saying that they all knew he would do the very best that he could.

A feast of handshaking and compliments ensued, accepting the new member, Mr. Maxwell, and expressing regrets that Mr. Conner was not to serve with them. The demonstration was so enthusiastic that even your humble servant was included.

At 8:40 P.M. Trustee Inman moved to adjourn. Trustee Wolfe seconded the motion, which was duly carried.
