MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance was held in the Council Chambers of Torrance, California, November 20, 1928, and was called to order at 7:45 P. M. by Mayor Dennis. The following Trustees were present: Maxwell, Wolfe and Dennis. Absent; Inman and Raymond.

Protests against change of zone, reclassifying certain lots, were called for, as this was the time set for hearing of such protests; and as none were voiced or filed, Trustee Maxwell introduced:

The minutes of the regular, adjourned meeting of November 13 were read and approved as read.

A letter of thanks from the Torrance Herald for the flowers sent on the occasion of the opening of their new building was read. This letter was ordered filed.

A letter of thanks from the American Legion for the cooperation of the City Council which was given them at their Armistice Day services, was read and ordered filed.

The Clerk read a petition from resident property owners on Redondo Boulevard between Portola and Madrid for the removal of certain trees in that section.

On motion by Trustee Maxwell, seconded by Trustee Wolfe, and carried, the Street Superintendent was instructed to look into this matter and report at the next regular meeting.

Attorney Briney read a report from the Railroad Commission, authorizing the widening of El Prado.

A communication from the Veterans' Welfare Board of the State of California for an order to cancel assessments on Lot 8, Block 62, Torrance Tract, was read.

Attorney Briney read:
