MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR  
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, June 11, 1929, and was called to order at 7: 45 P. M. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Nelson, Steiner and Dennis.  
Absent: Trustees Wolfe and Maxwell.

The minutes of the regular meeting of June 4th., 1929, were read and approved as read.

Clerk Bartlett read a communication drawn up by Engineer Leonard to the Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles, requesting an allocation of County Funds to apply toward the expense of grading and paving certain streets in the City of Torrance.

Trustee Nelson moved that the City Engineer be authorized to send the letter to the Board of Supervisors.

Trustee Steiner seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES: TRUSTEES: Nelson, Steiner and Dennis.  
NOES: " None.  
ABSENT: " Wolfe and Maxwell.

Oral communications were next in order:

The North Lomita Annexation Petition was discussed.

Trustee Nelson stated that the petition of annexation should stand as at last meeting, as there were no Kettler's present at the meeting.

Trustee Steiner suggested that the City Attorney write a letter to the Kettler's asking them to write the City Council stating whether they were desirous of coming into the City of Torrance, or to state their objections.

Trustee Steiner moved that all bills, properly audited, be paid.

Trustee Nelson seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES: TRUSTEES: Nelson, Steiner, and Dennis.  
NOES: " None.  
ABSENT: " Wolfe and Maxwell.

At this time the Kettler's arrived at the meeting, and the North Lomita Annexation Petition was again discussed. Mr. Kettler asked if they would be in the lighting district if they came into the City of Torrance. Mr. Leonard stated that there was no bonds issued for the overhead lights, and that only a small charge was made for maintenance.

Trustee Steiner suggested that the petition be held over till the regular meeting of June 18th., 1929, when Mr. Kettler would know definitely what he intended to do.

The meeting adjourned at 8: 30 P. M.
