MINUTES OF AN ADJOURNED REGULAR
MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

An adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, August 27th., 1929, and was called to order at 7:45 P. M. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Trustees: Nelson, Steiner and Dennis.

Absent: Trustees: Maxwell and Wolfe.

Mayor Dennis stated that as this was an adjourned regular meeting in order to pass on the tax rate for the fiscal year 1929-1930, the regular order of business would be suspended.

Clerk Bartlett read:

ORDINANCE NO. 192.

FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
1929-1930.

Trustee Steiner moved that Ordinance No. 192 be adopted for its final reading as an emergency ordinance.

Trustee Nelson seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

- AYES: TRUSTEES: Nelson, Steiner and Dennis.
- NOES: " None.
- ABSENT: " Maxwell and Wolfe.

Trustee Nelson reported that he had gotten in touch with the Auditors, and they would have the report here for the next meeting.

Trustee Steiner stated that the Ordinance from San Fernando, relative to the distribution of bills from house to house, which was read at the last meeting, was found to be unconstitutional..

Trustee Nelson suggest^s that the City Attorney draft up an Ordinance that would be constitutional.

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from the Torrance Motor Company, under date of August 26th., 1929, stating that the Lee Company, Manufacturers of the Lee Gear Clad Hoist, as specified in their bid of equipment on Chevrolet truck which was delivered to us, is now in the hands of the Receiver, and it is impossible to supply the hoist as specified.

As agreed with Mr. Gascoigne they are furnishing us with a Woods Hydraulic Hoist.

Mr. Hansen did not state in his letter that there would be no extra cost.

Trustee Steiner moved that the City Clerk be instructed to purchase five (5) loose-leaf book binders, such as the ordinances are bound in, for the Trustees to keep their minutes, papers, etc., in.

Trustee Nelson seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

- AYES: TRUSTEES: Nelson, Steiner and Dennis.
- NOES: " None.
- ABSENT: " Maxwell and Wolfe.

Trustee Steiner stated that a great many accidents were happening at the intersection of Engracia Avenue and Manuel Avenue, and while he was not in favor of too many Blvd. Stops in a city, he thought it very wise for one to be established at this corner.

Trustee Steiner moved that a Blvd. Stop be established at the intersection of Manuel Avenue and Engracia Avenue.

Trustee Nelson seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Clerk Bartlett read:

RESOLUTION NO. 434.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Torrance that a Blvd. Stop be established, in accordance with Ordinance No. 128, at the intersection of Manuel Avenue, and Engracia Avenue, such that traffic on Manuel Avenue shall stop before entering ~~Engracia~~ Avenue.

Trustee Nelson moved that Resolution No. 434 be adopted.

Trustee Steiner seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

- AYES: TRUSTEES: Nelson, Steiner and Dennis.
- NOES: " None.
- ABSENT: " Maxwell and Wolfe.

Trustee Steiner moved that the meeting be adjourned.

Trustee Nelson seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.
