MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF TORRANCE.

The regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, October 1st., 1929, and was called to order at 7:45 P. M. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Trustees: Maxwell, Nelson, Steiner and Dennis.

Absent: Trustee: Wolfe.

Trustee Steiner moved that the minutes of the regular meeting of September 17th., 1929, be adopted after the following correction. On introducing Ordinance No. 194, Trustee Steiner gave the wrong description of the property to be re-zoned. Should read:

Trustee Maxwell seconded the motion, which was carried unanimously.

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from G. A. Mark in regard to the garbage and rubbish collection within the city. He asks that the Council consider opening this up for bids.

This communication was ordered filed.

Clerk Bartlett read a communication from the County of Los Angeles, office of The Regional Planning Commission, under date of September 20th., 1929, presenting map of Tract No. 10719 for approval.

Engineer Leonard recommended that this map be approved.

Attorney Briney read:

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Torrance, that the map of proposed Tract No. 10719 this day presented to this City Council for approval, be and the same is hereby approved.

✓ Section 160, Fines and Forfeitures, of the California Vehicle Act as amended in 1929, and passed into effect on August 14th., 1929, was duly recognized and discussed by the City Council.

Trustee Steiner instructed Street Superintendent Gascoigne to purchase 1000' of 8" sewer pipe, also to stock up with 5000 brick.

The Chief of Police was instructed to have the red paint line on the south side of Cravens Avenue extended east four (4') feet, and the red paint line on the north side of the street painted over with white paint, also to paint diagonal parking lines on the north side of Sartori Avenue between El Prado and Post Avenue.

Trustee Steiner stated that many of the citizens of Torrance have asked him to have the City Attorney ascertain what proceedings a citizen or number of citizens would have to go through to have the reservoir drained and have the nuisance abated.

Trustee Nelson stated that we have not provided for a Reserve Fund in any of our Tax Reserves, and we have less than \$3000.00 on hand at the present time. With the bills that were O. K'd. to-night, we have more than spent that amount, so it will be necessary to issue warrants and register them the same as last year.

Trustee Steiner introduced

ORDINANCE NO. 196.

AMENDING THE LICENSE ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR FREE LICENSES TO DIS-ABLED VETERANS OF THE UNITED STATES OF ANY WARS.

The audit report was discussed. Trustee Nelson stated that the City Attorney should be given a list of the bills due the city, with instructions to attempt to effect a collection on them, and report his progress regularly to the board.

Trustee Nelson stated that the office should be commended on the good condition of the books, as was stated in the audit report and also told to others.

Trustee Nelson moved that the Annual Audit from Ernst and Ernst be accepted.
