MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TORRANCE.

A special meeting of the City Council of the City of Torrance, was held in the Council Chambers at Torrance, California, October 29th., 1929, and was called to order at 7:50 P. M. by Mayor Dennis.

The following Trustees were present: Trustees: Maxwell, Nelson, Steiner and Dennis.

Absent: Trustee: Wolfe.

Mayor Dennis stated that about the first of August of this year, Mr. H. H. Dolley, President of the Torrance Chamber of Commerce, appointed a committee consisting of Mr. Earl Conners, Mr. F. R. Leonard, City Engineer and himself, to investigate the water situation in Torrance. The purpose of this meeting was to receive the report of this committee.

At this time Mr. Leonard read the report of the committee.

Clerk Bartlett read a notice of intention to circulate a petition for annexation.

Trustee Steiner moved that the petition be accepted and filed.


Trustee Maxwell seconded the motion, which was duly carried by the following roll call vote:

AYES: TRUSTEES: Maxwell, Nelson, Steiner and Dennis,


NOES: " None.
